### Reflection

My Grandmother passed away eleven years ago today. I think of her often. She was a woman of great faith. To honor her, I have decided to spend this time reflecting on the positive influence she has had on my spiritual life.

When I was very young, my family would frequently visit our Grandparents. My Grandmother had religious items all around the house. As my Sister and I would be playing around, we would see all these things. I remember her bedroom with the statues of Mary and Jesus on her dresser. On the bedpost, she had hung her rosary beads. Holy Water was always nearby as well. While I didn't fully understand their significance at the time, I certainly knew that these things meant a lot to Grandma.

As I grew, I began to understand. I saw Grandma praying often. I saw her at Mass each week. Many family events had a Mass incorporated into them. As part of my reflection today, I wanted to see a picture of Grandma. The first picture that I found was an extended family picture taken after a Mass celebrating my Grandparent's anniversary. The picture could have been taken anywhere that day, but Grandma naturally decided that it would be taken in Church.

Eleven years ago, I went to visit her in a St. Vincent's hospital bed. Various family members gathered around her bed during this time as we all knew that her time with us was coming to an end. She could no longer communicate with us. While she lay there, she would periodically make the sign of the cross. At first I thought that this was some natural reflex, following a motion that she had repeated so many times before. Maybe something almost programmed into her. But as we all stood around her and she continued to do it, we finally realized that this was her way of asking us to pray with her one last time; and we did.

Without my Grandmother's influence, I know that my spiritual life wouldn't be the same today. Thank you Grandma for sharing your faith with me.
