Be Still and Listen

Listening is the hardest thing to do! When we are listening to someone and before that person is finished speaking, we are forming a response to what the person was saying. Or do we hear what we want to hear?

I took a course on effective listening. One part of the course was to listen to a tape of a person talking. We then had to write down what the person said. I heard only 20% of what was said. I missed the main points of the talk.

Have you ever sat in a place with a lot of noise; like a mall, on a street, or a party with all the distractions and try to remember what you heard?

In the first reading Samuel thought he had heard Eli calling him. Each time Eli told him that he did not call him, to go back to sleep. Eli realized that God was calling Samuel. Eli told Samuel, "The next time God calls say, **'Speak, for your servant is listening.'**"

The art of **listening** is a gift from God, which we need to have in order to hear God call to us and to be able to understand what he is asking of us.

At Mass, what did you hear when the word of God was proclaimed? When the Homily was given, did your mind wonder to all the things you have to do that day or week?

To hear God speaking to us, we need to **be still and listen.**

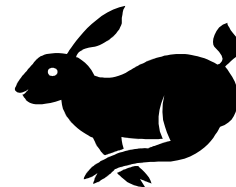
